

RECOMMENDED SEASONAL MAINTAINANCE SCHEDULE

- Change batteries in smoke detectors
- Have chimney checked and cleaned
- Review location of main electrical disconnect
- Insure that glass fireplace doors are in place and in good working order
- Review attic to insure proper insulation levels
- Make sure that attic vents are open and clear
- Feel around windows for drafts. Incense sticks can help with this task
- Review and verify breakers and what switches and outlets they operate
- Check Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) outlets by tripping the test button.
(NOTE: GFCI outlets should be in Kitchens, Bathrooms, Garage and Outside locations)
- Inspect each lamp, extension and appliance cord and plug, *replace* if frayed or broken
- Review the location of the main water shutoff
- Review the location of the main HOT water shutoff
- Review the location of each gas shutoff
- Check water lines under all sinks, toilet, washing machines and at the hot water heater for leaks. (NOTE: It is recommended that all non-solid plumbing, including washing machine hoses, be Stainless Steel Braided Hose, available at any home center)
- Change or clean furnace air filter (Monthly)
- Turn off humidifier
- Turn on humidifier
- Have heating and air systems inspected
- Lightly blow off your thermostat
- Update caulking around tub / shower units
- Repair / replace loose or damaged ceramic tile
- Tighten / repair cabinet and door hardware and hinges
- Check refrigerator gaskets
- Clean refrigerator coil and drip pan
- Review fire escape plan with your family
- Test smoke detectors
- Review the exterior of your home and make note of any damage or areas needing repair
- Clean grill and fins on the air conditioner
- Review your insurance policies to insure adequate coverage
